Recognizing the Lord

Reading I Acts 2:14, 22-33 (Peter's discourse)

Reading II 1 Peter 1:17-21 (filial obedience)

Gospel Luke 24:13-35 (Emmaus)

Key Passage: When he was at the table with the disciples, he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him; and he vanished from their sight. (Luke 24:30-31).

Saint of the Week

Saint Athanasius

On May 2nd the Church celebrates the Memorial of Saint Athanasius. Born in Alexandria around 295, Athanasius was elected bishop of that city in 328. He was a strenuous supporter of Catholicism against Arianism, which had been condemned by the Council of Nicea (325), but remained the cause of doubt and division in the Eastern Church. Athanasius was unshakable in his defense of Christian orthodoxy against the Arian heresy. Because of this, he became a target of attacks by heretics. He was sent into exile five times, totaling 17 years. Athanasius died May 2, 373. He is a Father of the Church and is counted as one of the four great Eastern Doctors of the Church in the Roman Catholic Church. St. Athanasius is the patron of Theologians, and faithful Orthodox and Roman Catholic Christians.
